We are a specialist education service supporting children and young people in Nottingham City who have been diagnosed with a physical disability

Our team consists of a coordinator/ teacher of children with a physical disability an occupational therapist, moving and handling advisor and IT support

We work in schools and other settings to promote inclusion.

We offer you and your family information, support and advice on your child's physical disability.

What do we do?

- We give information, support and advice on the impact of a child's physical disability
- We provide consultation and planning with teachers and teaching assistants on modification to the curriculum
- We provide specialist ICT assessments
- We provide reports in order to help families and schools to understand the child's needs.
- We work with children at school and in other settings to develop skills, reinforce learning and provide specialist, modified resources.
- We provide additional support when a child is moving into nursery/school or when changing schools.
- We carry out environmental audits to make sure that the school or setting is safe
- We work alongside other professionals involved with the child to make sure they understand the implications of a physical disability.



Training

We offer training that includes:

- Moving and handling
- Access to the curriculum
- Adapting resources
- Use of specialist equipment
